















## Criteria for Town Green Registration

The registration authority will look for evidence having been met, namely that:

"a significant number of inhabitants of any locality, or any neighbourhood within a locality indulged...in lawful sports and pastimes

as of right

on the land

for a period of twenty years"













## LCC Grounds for Objection

- 1. Failure to identify appropriate locality or neighbourhood
- 2. Failure to demonstrate a significant number/spread of users
- 3. Statutory Incompatibility

If the County Council needed to provide a new school or extra accommodation in Lancaster in order to fulfil its statutory duty, it would not be able to do that on the Application Land were it to be registered as a Town or Village Green

4. Failure to demonstrate that the land was used as of right
