

## **Greenspace Groups Forum**

### **Meeting held 26/1/15 at Morecambe Town Hall**

**The evening's topic was 'Green Infrastructure Planning'.**

#### **The forward planning team gave a presentation on the planning process:**

Maurice gave us an overview of the process and where we are up to with the various documents that make up the Local Plan. His team have a difficult task in finding space for new housing and other infrastructure in accordance with central government requirements, because so much of the district is either protected areas, or designated flood plain.

Rebecca then explained the 'Local Green Spaces' designation and where she was up to in developing a methodology that would lead to a call for sites and public comments in a couple of months time.

Kelly then explained the many colours of her maps and we all got stuck into identifying green spaces that were known and valued by ourselves, and might warrant designation as a Local Green Space. We also tried to identify water features and opportunities for creating/enhancing wildlife corridors. We also suggested that if possible, Common Land is added as a map layer, together with any known well-used informal paths and cycle that are not Rights of Way.

Update: Simon has added our comments to the Council's PPG17 study database; this includes 16 new greenspace sites.
